




## CENTREVILLE DAY CITIZENS of the YEAR

2022 marks 30 years of celebrating Centreville and Centreville Day. The Centreville Day Planning Committee thus thought it was fitting to recognize members of our community who have consistently served their neighbors over many years. Join us in thanking Celeste Peterson, Keener Insurance, and Ted McCord for their many contributions to our community.



#### Celeste Peterson: Centreville Day Citizen of the Year

More than 20 years ago Celeste Peterson reached out to Fairfax County Public Schools to organize afterschool activities to encourage middle school girls to explore and develop an interest in STEM. In 2006 she began serving on FCPS' Partners in Education Advisory Board and would become its co-chair in 2008. Following the tragic death of her daughter, Erin, Celeste and her husband Grafton began the Erin Peterson Fund to honor their daughter's dedication to education and helping others. The Fund has since given away more than \$260,000 for scholarships and grants in programs that are Centreville focused. Each year the Fund grants scholarships to two Westfield students. The Fund also supports two mentoring programs, one focused on fostering leadership among young men at

Westfield Highschool and the other, GRACE (Girls Reaching for Academic & Cultural Excellence) assists girls both in high school and Stone Middle School. The Erin Peterson Fund also gives new winter coats to Centreville children via their Koats for Kids program. The Fund is ready to help meet other community needs; during the pandemic they started the Fuel Station, a food pantry at Westfield for students, and gave away Walmart gift cards. As Celeste explained in a recent interview with the Centre View: "The need is right here in our own community ... . this is the way for me to honor Erin and Grafton. I'm thankful to God that He blessed me with being Erin's mother for 18 years, and I'm serious about putting good into the community in her name."



#### **Keener Insurance: Centreville Day Business of the Year**

Since 1973, almost 50 years, Keener Insurance has been an integral member of the Centreville community. When the need was identified, Keener Insurance offered space in his office building to house a fledgling local food bank that has since become the phenomenal Western Fairfax Christian Ministries. #### Ted McCord: Honored Community Historian

Professor McCord recently moved from Mount Gilead, his home for 27 years. Ted was much more than the resident caretaker of this historic house, he investigated its history, hosted descendants of residents, even helped to dig with an archaeological investigation on the premises. Ted has been essential to keeping Mount Gilead a living part of the Centreville community by graciously opening his home on Centreville Day and on many other occasions for groups interested in a tour. He has long served on the board of the Historic Centreville

Society and, more recently, the Friends of Historic Centreville. Ted taught for many years in the History Department at George Mason University where he focused on the history of colonial Virginia. He is currently writing a biography of John Page of Rosewell.


