On this 31st Centreville Day, the Planning Committee is proud to continue to recognize individuals and groups that have given the greater Centreville community years of service, leadership, and heart.

Bill Hatcher, Centreville Day Lifetime Service Award



Some years ago, when Bill Hatcher was offered thanks for his support and service, his reply was that it was his joy to serve the community. Bill has been a part of the Centreville community since 1960, when he moved to Stone Road at age 6. He began his lifetime of service working as a lifeguard at Chantilly National Country Club. In 1975, Bill joined the Centreville Baptist Church and in 1990, became a full-time pastor. As Outreach Pastor, Bill organized church members to support the community in many different ways. For example, in 2010, Bill and Centreville Baptist were awarded the Don Early Award and in 2011 were recognized as Outstanding Volunteers for helping the Walney Garden Guild create and maintain gardens over several years at Ellanor C. Lawrence Park. For many years since 2011, Bill and his team of dedicated volunteers lent critical support to Centreville Day by providing the free shuttle bus service. There is even a rumor that Bill drove a bus a time or two. We appreciate Bill's lifetime of altruistic service in support of the places, people, and events that are the best of Centreville.

Reverend Dr. Eugene Johnson, Centreville Day Lifetime Leadership Award



Dr. Johnson grew up in Louisiana but has lived in Centreville with his family for many years. He served as pastor of Mount Olive Church from 1992 to 2023. In 2018, Governor Northam noted how Rev. Johnson led efforts to made the church a "model of civic engagement." Over the last 30 years he has led the church to rebuild after a devastating fire; to overcome the unimaginable impacts of 9/11 and the DC sniper; to assist with HIV-AIDS prevention, to be a community site for COVID vaccinations; to provide food baskets for community members during the pandemic; and to be an enthusiastic partner to Centreville Elementary School, which included sending weekend food home in student backpacks. We wish to thank and honor Rev. Johnson for his 30-plus years of selfless giving and leadership to benefit the well-being of our community.

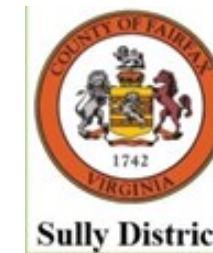
