



CENTREVILLE DAY CITIZENS of the YEAR

More than most years 2020-2021 has needed caring neighbors willing to reach out and help. Centreville Day's Citizens of the Year for 2021 exemplify community spirit and goodwill.

'I've Been Blessed, and I Try to Give Back': Ciao Osteria, Business of the Year

As the pandemic took hold in March 2020 and restaurants had to close down their dinning rooms, Ciao's owner Salvatore Speziale, began to organize delivery of free meals to Emergency Room nurses at Fair Oaks hospital. It quickly expanded to include other hospitals, housekeeping staff, firefighters, and the police. A GoFundMe page was established, donations poured in, and exceeded the original \$100,000 goal. By October of this year, Ciao had prepared more than 22,500 meals.

Mr. Speziale's family immigrated from Italy and struggled economically when they arrived here. Sal attended the Air Force Academy and served in the Air Force before becoming a commercial airline pilot.

Speziale sees a few positive things coming out of the pandemic: "I think this is kind of a kick in the rear from above where somebody's saying, 'you guys better take care of each other, and love each other, and, and be nice to each other, because ... we're all in the same boat, you know, and we better be good to each other," he said. "It's gonna be a different world when we wake up out of this and a different country, you know, but I think it'll be a better country."

Partners in the Community: WFCM, Nonprofit of the Year

Western Fairfax Christian Ministries has been helping neighbors in Centreville and Chantilly since 1987. In 2020, they provided the equivalent of nearly 268,000 meals and helped keep over 2,000 individuals housed. In February of this year the Virginia State assembly recognized WFCM's work during the pandemic. WFCM maintained it's regular hours and continued receiving food donations via Amazon within covid restrictions. In June 2020 they partnered with Lazy Dog in Chantilly to create a food and job security program to purchase food for clients while supporting a local business. WFCM also worked with Mellow Mushroom to build and distribute Make Your Own Pizza Kits for local children. Overall, WFCM works with over 100 government, non-profit, and business partners, including Centreville Day sponsor Wegman's Chantilly, to help those in need.




